Position

Our shopping can help people empower people affected by leprosy. When people purchase from The Leprosy Mission Catalogue, they have a double impact: empowering people affected by leprosy and disability who produce many of the products, and the profits help people affected by leprosy.

You would receive goods on consignment and would sell them at your church, car boot sales, or wherever else you might have the opportunity. You could even make a night of it and invite people over for a night of coffee, desserts and shopping from the goods you have on display!

Tasks

- 1. Receiving of stock from The Leprosy Mission Australia.
- 2. Keep an eye for opportunities
- 3. Set up and run stall
- 4. Requesting of other props for stalls (Eg. If banners or table cloths are needed)
- 5. Collect and reconcile goods sold and money raised accurately
- **6.** Manage and adjust stock quantities as required.

Schedule and commitment.

Events vary depending on the seasons and the areas that you are in. You can commit to as many or as few events as you would like. We only ask that you keep us informed 2-3 months in advance so we can allocate our stock accordingly.

We also ask that if you are unable to follow through with an event and payments (to the event organisers for stall space as an example) have already been made, please organise a replacement.
